Dialogue N-S brings together a large number of artists from different geographical areas, creating a space for dialogue, practices, narratives and contexts from the Northern and Southern hemispheres, highlighting the visual bridges between different artists. The curatorial project proposes a meeting place for diverse stories, territories and artistic languages, reflecting on the ways in which contemporary art crosses geographical, political and cultural boundaries, challenging fixed interpretations of the global world.

Integrated into the celebration of Perve Galeria's 25th anniversary, this exhibition takes on a symbolic character, functioning as a synthesis of the institution's trajectory, marked by a continued attention to the dynamics of Global Art and the valorisation of artists and narratives often underrepresented in the dominant circuits. Dialogue N-S reflects the discursive coherence that has guided the gallery's programme over time, promoting transversal relationships between different contexts of artistic production and encouraging critical and plural readings of contemporaneity.

The exhibition brings together works by artists from countries such as Canada, Ukraine, the United Kingdom, India, Pakistan, Argentina, Chile, Colombia, Portugal, Spain, Mozambique and South Africa, among others, constructing a pluralistic panorama where different generations, languages and aesthetic positions coexist. This collection highlights affinities, tensions and resonances between practices developed in different contexts, emphasising art as a territory of mediation, dialogue and critical thinking.

Among the artists featured are Hein Semke, João Artur da Silva, Malangatana, Teresa Roza d'Oliveira, Reinata Sadimba, Inácio Matsinhe, Figueiredo Sobral, Márcia Matonse, Valter Hugo Mãe, Ivan Villalobos, Aldo Alcota, Javier Félix, Sónia Aniceto, Vanessa Paz, Marya Al Qassimi, Liudvika Koort, Andreas Treske, Renée Gagnon, Sebastião Resende, José Chambel, Bogdan Gulyay, Dear Anushka, Valentim Popov, Fred Kradolfer, Claude Yersin, Carlos Zíngaro, João Ribeiro, Vitor Pi, Tor Seidel, among many others.

Dialogue N-S thus proposes an artistic cartography in constant motion, where North and South are not understood as fixed opposites, but as spaces of circulation, contamination and reinvention.
